1. Previous Minutes

The previous minutes were approved as a true and accurate record.

2. Matters Arising

HW explained that the plan is still to move the third line of Tattersall bookmakers due to health and safety when the redevelopment work is coming to an end in the summer. LJPC to sit in the summer.

3. Open Meeting

NP told the LJPC that the two main points raised at the open meeting were:-

- Warwick's redevelopment and how it will affect the bookmakers and the moving of the third line in Tattersalls.

HW said that any bookmakers with any concerns should feel free to speak to him.

4. Designated Numbers

As minuted at the previous meeting, Alan Carter, a rails bookmaker, has sent a letter to the LJPC for an increase in the designated number on the rails from six to eight on the busier days. HW stated that he could see no evidence to support the number being raised as crowd figures are down. PM stated that Tatts rarely or never fills. TM agreed that the number should remain at six as business doesn't warrant an increase.

Therefore it was agreed to keep the rails designated number at six.
