Minutes of the meeting held at Redcar Racecourse 21 November 2005

1.	MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING The minutes of the meeting held on 3 December 2004 were read and approved by members as a true record.
2.	PUBLISHING OF THE LJPC MINUTES ON THE NJPC WEBSITE MR explained to members that 2005 minutes will be published on the NJPC website. MR stated that this was for transparency and integrity purposes, and to give Bookmakers an insight to LJPC meetings. Members were also informed that draft copies would be sent out for their approval prior to the minutes being published.
3.	MATTERS ARISING (i) JR informed members that not all Bookmakers were registered with respective associations for public liability cover. MR reassured members that unless Bookmakers presented proof of public liability cover, Bookmakers would not be registered to work with the NJPC for the forthcoming 2006 season. (ii) JJS stated that there was a high probability that Catterick would have a single price structure for Tattersalls and Members on Tuesday (E) 9 May 2006, and that the Silver Ring would be closed for that meeting. Confirmation of this arrangement would be given early in the new year.

4.	DESIGNATED NUMBERS Due to the ongoing investigation by the OFT into designated numbers MR recommended that 2006 numbers remain unchanged. All members agreed to this. Catterick race on Sunday for the first time (1 January 2006-NH), and the upper tier numbers of: Rails 6, Tattersalls 33 and Silver 6, was agreed. Other changes included Wednesday 25 January 2006 (NH)-was previously Saturday 22 January 2005 (NH)-change to: Rails 6, Tattersalls 25, Silver 3. Thursday 28 December 2006 remains unchanged at: Rails 6, Tattersalls 33, Silver 6.
5.	ANY OTHER BUSINESS JJS stated to members that an incident occurred where a Bookmaker's assistant had used a reciprocal badge to gain admittance to the racecourse. JJS pointed out that Bookmakers and their assistants are not permitted to use Annual Members or reciprocal badges and must purchase the appropriate Bookmakers/Clerks badge outside the entrance to Tattersalls. JJS asked MR about administration fees paid to the NJPC. MR stated that from 1 January 2006 administration fees would be reduced from £11 to £10 for Rails/Tattersalls and Silver remains unchanged at £3. NO OTHER BUSINESS MEETING CLOSED
