Minutes of Meeting Tuesday 11th October 2005

1. Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved

2. Matters Arising

KG stated that the new Silver Ring layout had now been in use for over a year and Bookmakers had accepted it.

3. KG stated that the minutes of this meeting will be published on the NJPC Website for the information of all Bookmakers.

4. Bookmaker Parking Arrangements.

PA stated that the area in front of the Racecourse was being redeveloped and turned into a pedestrian area, therefore Bookmakers would not be allowed to park to unload their equipment, however a new area which will be clearly sign posted and designated for Bookmaker unloading will be provided.

5. Betting Ring Layouts.

PA wished to point out that Market Rasen is looking towards redeveloping each enclosure which may include extending the Members area into the Tattersalls area. This is unlikely to take place in the next two years. GA asked if the front line in Tattersalls could be extended into the new bar area. PA stated that this was not practicable as this is a drinking and viewing area and would create a barrier if Bookmakers were situated in that area. She also stated that it would not be advisable to change any Betting Rings until future plans had been decided.
