Silver Ring Bookmakers please note for 2006 a new mound is being constructed next to the existing mound and therefore throughout 2006 pitches on the old mound will not be used. All pitches will be in one straight line of 17 on the lower part of the ring There will be no anchorage points in 2006.. The existing mound will form part of Tattersalls in 2007 and consideration for pitches to be placed on the new mound will be made at the end of the year. The Silver Ring on 12/13/14 July 2006 will be shut to the general public however on all three days there will be a corporate tent holding approximately 200 people.

4. REDEVELOPMENT JULY COURSE

C.M. gave detailed description of the effect the redevelopment of the July Course would have on the Bookmakers Rings. The Members Rail would be moved to the end of the Grandstand(at present Tatts Ring) and all the Grandstand would become Members therefore increasing this capacity by 1800.

The Tatts Ring would be extended to include the mound at present in the Silver Ring and the Silver Ring would continue after Tatts. A new mound would be constructed in the Silver Ring. The attendance capacity in Tatts and Silver would remain unchanged. C.M asked C.A. whether he would have any objections to more Tatts Ring Bookmakers being located on the grass. C.A. stated that he could see no problems with this suggestion. C.A. to provide C.M with a preferred layout of the new Tatts Ring by Spring 2006.

A new mound would be in place near the original mound in the Silver Ring(Family Enclosure). C.A. to discuss layout of Silver Ring with C.M. for 2006/ 2007.

L.H. stated that the track would be applying for the repositioning of a Betting Shop under the Grandstand(Members) and may also apply for the repositioning of a Betting Shop in Tatts. C.A. & R.G. stated that they would have no objections providing these shops were not in addition to the current numbers.
